


Have you cleaned the floors of your home and found coins under your bed? Reached down for the TV remote in your couch and found lost coins? Do you recycle your beverage containers?


A friendly reminder: **The "Breakfast Club"**, donations of cereal to help feed the hungry, **happens at St. Matthew's on the last Sunday of each month**.

Oh, the headaches of snail mail! St. Matthew's has had a difficult time over the last year with mailbox break-ins, and our incoming and outgoing mail arriving slowly, not at all, or arriving in the hands of people where it shouldn't.

Fraud is on the rise everywhere. One of the ways to reduce our risk is to encourage you to make your gifts and offerings to St. Matthew's through online giving. When you choose to give online, your donation will transfer directly from your bank account (or debit or credit card) to our bank account. It is a convenient and secure way to make a one-time or recurring donation.

To give online, visit our website at <a href="https://www.stmattsumc.com">https://www.stmattsumc.com</a> and click on DONATIONS. This will take you to our giving page at <a href="mailto:churchcenter.com">churchcenter.com</a> (stmatthews@churchcenter.com).

Just fill out the form. There is a dropdown for you to tell us which category of giving (pledge, UMCOR, etc.). You will be asked to enter your email address or phone number to get a security code. Your log-in will give you the ability to pay directly from your bank account, or by credit card. You can set up a recurring donation(s) and to view your prior online donations. You can set it and forget it.


Direct Pay: By entering your bank's routing and account number, you can make a one-time or recurring donation. This is a very cost-effective way to give to St. Matthew's as the fee to us is only \$.35

Credit & Debit Cards: Many people choose to use debit cards as an alternative to paper checks or exercise responsible use of credit cards as a way to conveniently manage

expenses. Many cards today offer valuable points, such as air miles, which can be an added incentive. You can also set up one-time or recurring donations. You will not incur any fees in making this choice.
